OPS's START (Screening Tools and Referral Training) trainings are designed for pediatric primary care teams (medical providers, nurses, medical assistants, integrated mental health providers, and administrative staff). The depression training includes information on prevalence and morbidity, screening tools, assessment, treatment, and medication management. The suicide prevention training includes how to identify and address pediatric suicide risk using standardized screening and assessment tools, lethal means restriction, safety planning, referral, and structured follow-up.

The trainings are offered for free (with support from OHA Health Systems Division). Up to 4 Continuing Medical Education AMA PRA Category 1 Credits™ are available upon completion of training and evaluation.
