



# SW Oregon Opioid Summit

The opioid epidemic demands an effective regional approach that reflects the particular challenges and opportunities that providers, health systems and communities face in the Southwest region of Oregon.

- EXPAND ACCESS TO TREATMENT SERVICES for opioid dependence and overdose prevention
